NOTES ON THE EXAMINATIONS

Please read carefully the examination regulations printed below:

- (a) Any candidate who fails to put down correctly his/her full **Index Number** will have his/her paper cancelled.
- (b) Candidates will be permitted into the examination room with their own slide rules and battery operated cordless noiseless pocket-size calculators without print-out or memory capacities.
- (c) The examination regulations PROHIBIT a student from:
 - i. Taking into the examination room or possessing, while in that room, any books, notes or other materials except that which has been authorized by the Examination Supervisor or Invigilator.
 - ii. Aiding or attempting to aid another candidate, obtaining or attempting to obtain aid from another candidate.
 - iii. Failing to obey any instruction from the Examination supervisor or invigilator.
 - iv. Giving false or misleading information to the Examination Supervisor.
